The Westminster Shorter Catechism (1647)

Questions 63-66

Leader: Which is the fifth commandment?

People: The fifth commandment is, Honor thy father and thy mother; that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.

Leader: What is required in the fifth commandment?

People: The fifth commandment requires the preserving the honor, and performing the duties, belonging to everyone in their several places and relations, as superiors, inferiors or equals.

Leader: What is forbidden in the fifth commandment?

People: The fifth commandment forbids the neglecting of, or doing anything against, the honor and duty which belongs to everyone in their several places and relations.

Leader: What is the reason annexed to the fifth commandment?

People: The reason annexed to the fifth commandment is a promise of long life and prosperity (as far as it shall serve for God's glory and their own good) to all such as keep this commandment.
